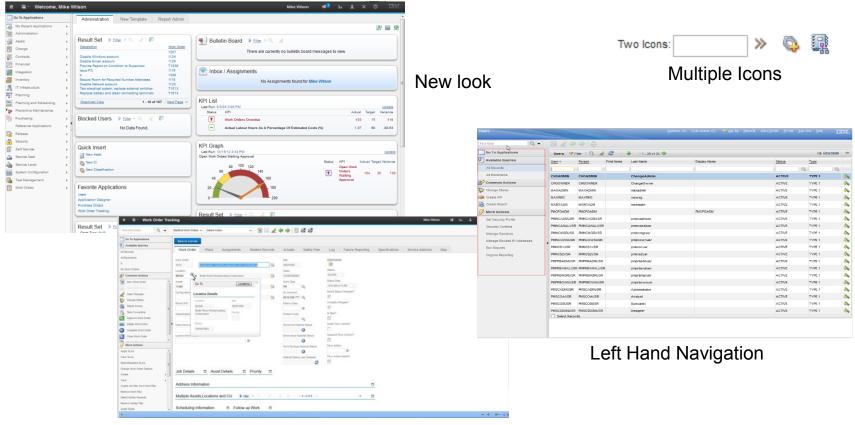
Examples:

- Create Dialogs that appear over a field to provide details like full name, phone number and email address when hovering over a field like employee ID.
- Configure start center results sets to include data from multiple related records, like including planned labor information along side the corresponding workorder header details.
- Allow users to put a record in edit mode blocking other users from making changes to that record.



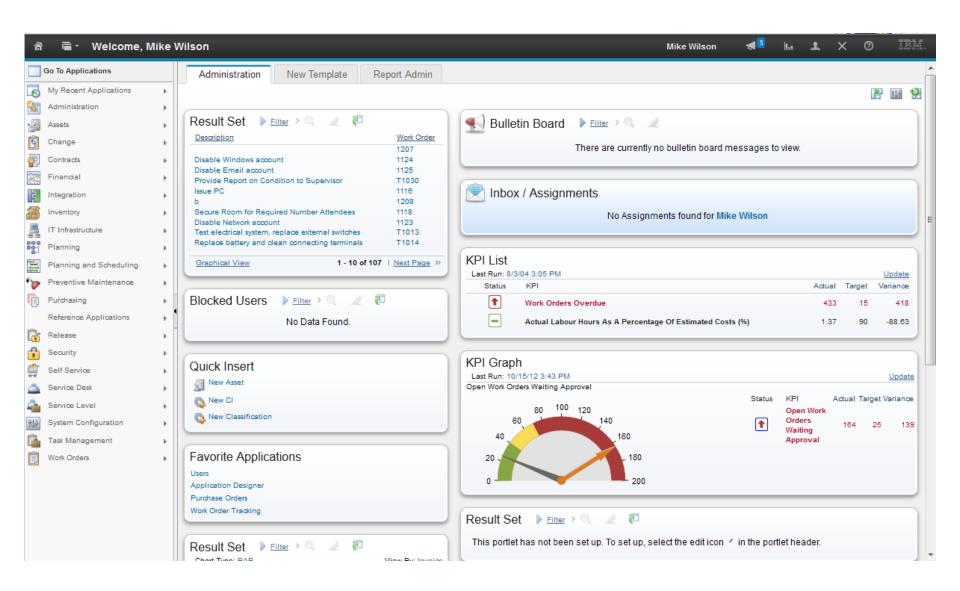
Improving the User Experience

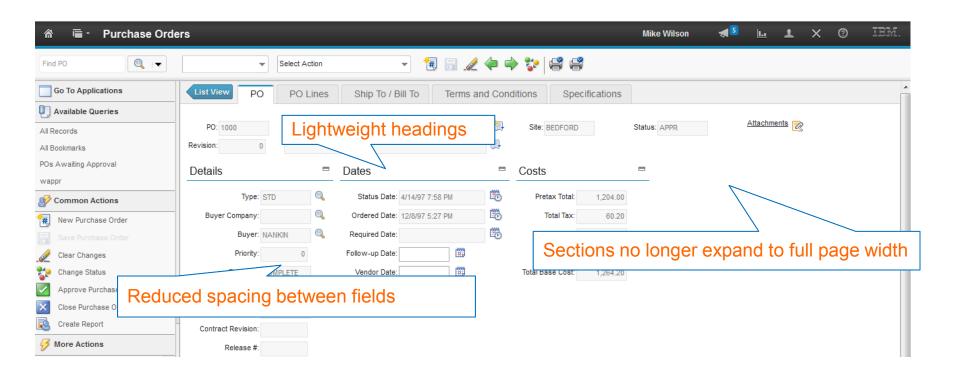


User Interface styling changes - new skin (tivoli13)

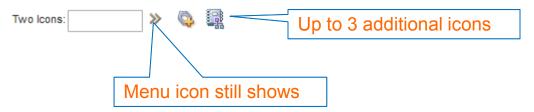

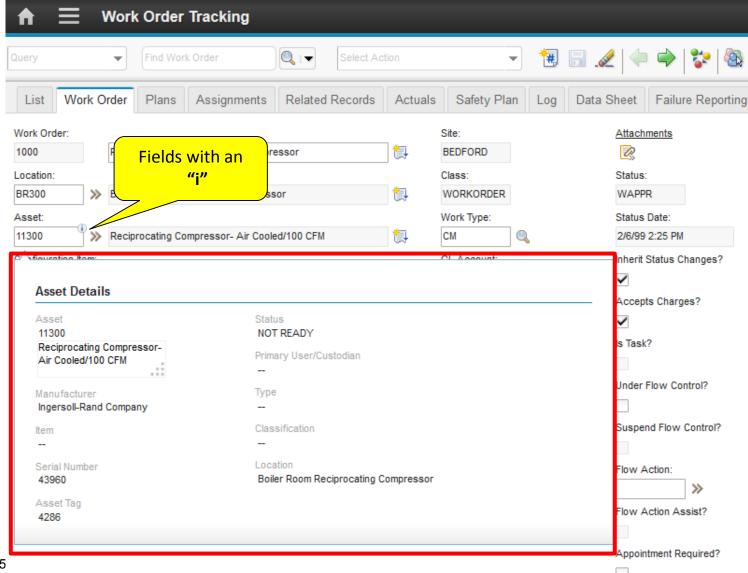

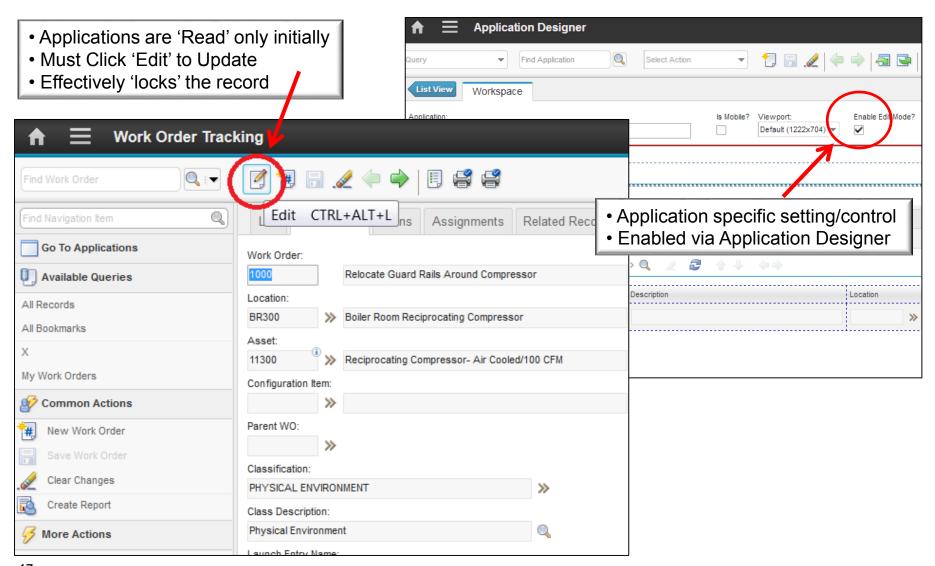

Allows users to access any existing IBM Maximo application on an iPhone, iPad, iPod touch, Android or other supported device without installing anything on those devices







Maximo Everyplace enables users to:

- Shorten the lag time between an event's occurrence and the recording of that event in the system. there's no need to wait until they get back to their desk to enter or retrieve data.
- Increase accuracy of data in the system by allowing them to enter information while it's fresh in their minds.
- Offer convenient, targeted access to Maximo for workers who don't regularly sit at a desk or use a desktop computer.

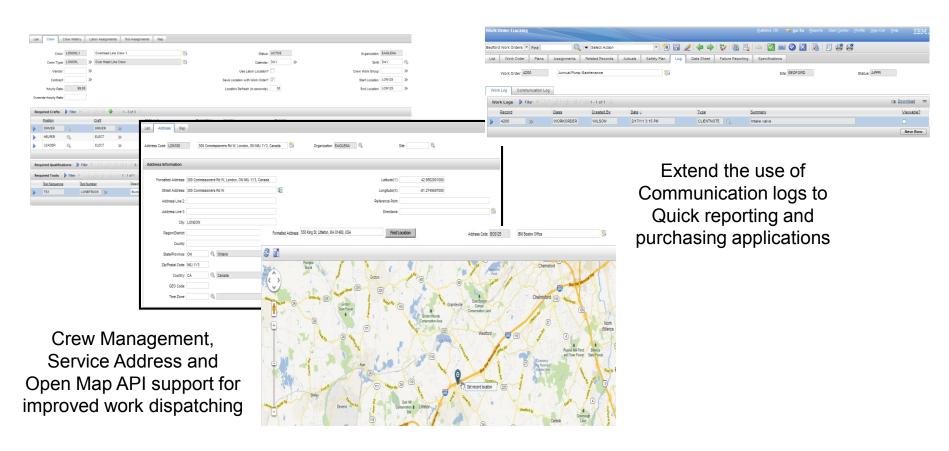
Examples:

- Options for defining a crew of individuals allow a planner to generically schedule rather than accommodate each individuals availability.
- Ability to capture details about an asset or locations location so it can be displayed on a map.
- Insert comments when communicating with a requestor about details of a requested part so it can be referenced downstream.

- Apply site and set restrictions to Cognos meta data published from Maximo so users creating or executing reports in Cognos only see data they have access to



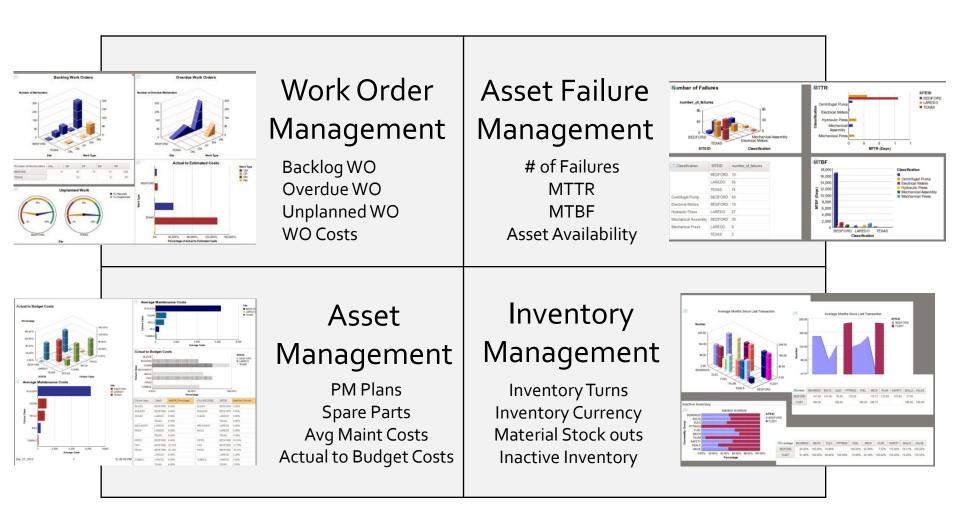

Examples:

- Administrators use the same technology when installing many of IBM's solutions including Maximo, middleware and databases reducing training time.
- Support latest version of middleware and expand browser options to include Chrome.
- Serviceability improvement wherein custom log messages are injected into log files for easier isolation of a test block within the log file
- Connection leak prevention improves server resiliency to long running connections.
- Better utilization of resources through cron task load balancing options.



Multi Tenancy Capabilities

- Separate Install Package within Passport
 - One time choice cannot move between MT and Non-MT
 - Cannot upgrade into an MT enabled environment
 - Support for DB2 only
- Reduced administrative overhead for Hosting scenarios
- Template data supports the ability to quickly onboard new tenants and encourages best practices
- Provides true separation of data and configurations between 'tenants' within the same instance of Maximo
 - Allows individual tenant business processes and screen designs
 - Robust data security (no cross visibility)
- Overall improvements to performance due to potentially expediential increase in users
