

Florida Digital Classroom Plan Overview

Through House Bill 5101, the Florida Department of Education will provide your district with at least \$250,000 to improve student performance through digital learning, professional development, and online assessments.

To qualify for this funding, your district is required to submit a Digital Classroom Plan to the Florida DOE by October 1, 2014.

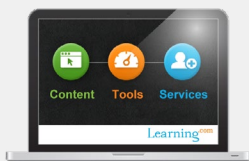


How to Qualify

Your Digital Classroom Plan will need to show how your district will meet the following criteria outlined in the new law:

- **Student Performance Outcomes:** improve classroom teaching and learning to enable all students to be digital learners with access to digital tools and resources for the full integration of the Florida Standards.
- **Digital Learning and Technology Infrastructure:** high-level digital learning and technology strategies that will help achieve the goals of the district.
- **Professional Development:** instructional personnel and staff shall have access to opportunities and training to assist with the integration of technology into classroom teaching.
- **Digital Tools:** implement and support a digital tools system that assists district instructional personnel and staff in the management, assessment and monitoring of student learning and performance.
- **Online Assessment Readiness:** reduce the amount time used for the administration of computer-based assessments.
