Facility management

- 1 **Access Control System.** The system controller and software combination provides the foundation for access control, site security, and facility management solutions.
- 2 **Site Graphics.** Nothing demonstrates security like the status of every unit displayed graphically in the main office. Customized and color-coded facility maps provide the ability to quickly track site activity and guide prospective tenants to featured units.
- 3 **Bollard Stands for Access Devices.** Bollards are powder-coated so they can be painted to match the appearance of the facility. Single and dual keypad bollards are offered. The bollard that accommodates two keypads has a higher height for ease of use by individuals in larger vehicles, such as RVs.
- 4 **Alert Systems.** Alert systems can be placed anywhere it is important to detect a pedestrian or vehicle approaching. Use these wired or wireless products with a gate operator to create an effective and economical solution that provides peace of mind.
- 5 **Multi-floor Elevator Controls.** Add a keypad to an elevator and control tenant access to specific floors.
- 6 **Code and Card Tenant Access Devices.** Put keypads with four-line display, color camera, and added relays at entrances and exits to identify everyone on the site at the time of vandalism or theft. Secure entrances to wine rooms or areas for pharmaceutical or document storage. Models with magnetic swipe or proximity card readers are available.
- 7 **Radio Frequency Transmitters.** Hand-held RF transmitters enable self-storage owners and operators to generate additional revenues. Tenants gain the convenience of access to the main gate and units with the press of a button, if equipped with gate and door operators. These devices are especially beneficial for facilities with boat and RV storage.
- 8 **Individual Unit Door Alarms.** These devices attract prospective tenants by increasing security at the unit and owners will benefit from this competitive advantage. Premium secured areas equipped with additional door alarms can command higher rental rates. Wired and wireless versions are available.
- 9 **Music and Paging Systems.** A music system can soften a stark environment. Owners can leverage their investment by using paging to communicate site-wide or to individuals. Managers can add prerecorded messages and site announcements.
- 10 **Automatic Commercial Gate Operators.** Slide gate operators are the most common form of perimeter access control at self-storage facilities. An added barrier arm gate operator provides anti-tailgating features. Swing and space-saving vertical lift gate operators are also available.
- 11 **Intercom Systems.** An intercom system that connects the office with substations throughout the facility provides tenants with a method for contacting the office at all times, enhancing the sense of security at the facility.
- 12 **Automatic Commercial Door Operators.** Commercial door operators are effective for facilities with premium individual units for boat and RV storage.
- 13 **Overlock System.** When an Overlock system is included in the facility solution, owners and site managers gain the ability to enhance customer services, streamline operations, and maximize profitability. Minimize laborious lock and door checks. Become more effective at delinquency processes. Discourage tailgating into the facility. Add a layer of security and improve documentation of site activity.
