About the Course Completion Exam (CCE)

- CCEs can be accessed using the Automic Learning Management System (LMS) at http://automic.netexam.com
- Each user must have a valid login to access the LMS and take the CCE
- The CCE is in multiple choice format, using an automated rotating question pool
- Each CCE is included when a student is enrolled in the particular course
- CCEs may be purchased separately without attending or completing the course at the cost of one (1) eLearning credit

About General Certification

- Certifications are automatically earned once all the CCEs have been passed in the correct path.
- A student who has completed the CCEs should send an email to learningportal@automic.com for verification
- Once verification is confirmed by Automic University. a certificate will be mailed out to the student from the Bellevue office

About Expert Certification

- Expert Certification can only be achieved once a General Certification has been achieved, and a CCE has been completed in a valid Elective topic and the formal proctored Expert Exam has been passed and a verification request has been sent to learningportal@ automic.com
- Expert Exams will be offered as an option annually at the Automic World Conference in Europe and the USA.
- The Expert Exam will contain practical information that will need to be demonstrated by completing tasks inside the Automation Engine. This is not a multiple-choice test, but one that requires practical experience and is scored by the instructor


About Master Certification

• An AWA Master Certification is automatically achieved when a student has completed both Expert Design and Expert Administration Certifications.














FAO:

1. What is the difference between the old "AE Basics" and the new "AWA Design 1" class?

The major difference is that "Design 1" is based upon the new Automic Web Interface (AWI), so the user interface is quite different. It may also contain information and features that are only available in versions above v11.2. Also, some information has been split out into the Foundations and Design 2 classes.

2. If I have taken "AE Basics" before, do I need to retake the entire "AWA Design 1" class?

Not necessarily, as the core information will be very similar. You will want to familiarize yourself with v12 features in a self-study format since some CCE questions may relate specifically to the AWI

3. I've been working with the Automation Engine for quite a while. How can I prove my certification level without spending dozens of hours in a classroom?

Each course has a Course Completion Exam. Passing this exam is the same as passing the course.

4. How can I attend one of these instructor-led courses?

Contact your Account Manager to have Professional Services come onsite to train up to 12 of your team membersAttend a regional training class (http://www.automic.com/upcoming-courses) in Germany (in German), the UK, or the USA

5. A particular class I want to take isn't being offered in my region/timeframe but I need to get certified. What can I do?

You can get a list of the topics covered and study on your own using the documentation (http://docs.automic.com) and then purchase the relevant CCE using an eLearning credit

6. Do Automic employees and partners automatically achieve AWA Master Certification?

No. Automic employees (Support, PreSales, Professional Services, Consultants, etc.) and partners achieve certifications in the same way customers do: passing the required exams that prove their knowledge

7. Are all courses currently available?

No. Courses will be released as they have been completed. It may take through the 2017 year for the complete certification path to be available.
