

CONSTITUTION AND CITIZENSHIP DAY (SEPTEMBER 17th)

Vantage College complies with the “Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2005.”

The laws states that “each educational institution that receives Federal funds for a fiscal year shall hold an educational program on the United States Constitution on September 17 of such year for the students served by the educational institution.” The law requires that Constitution Day be held on September 17 of each year, commemorating the September 17, 1787 signing of the Constitution. However, when September 17 falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday, Constitution Day shall be held during the preceding or following week
