



European Union REACH Compliance

August 11, 2016

With respect to compliance with the EU's Registration, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) Regulation (EC No. 1907/2006), Laserage Technology Corporation ("Laserage") makes the following statement.

Awareness and Focus

Laserage is fully aware of the European REACH regulations. Laserage has programs and resources in place to deal with all legislative requirements in the jurisdictions in which it operates. Please refer to our Global Code of Conduct for our specific commitments.

Registration

Since Laserage exports only Articles (as defined in REACH Regulation Article 3(3)), and those Articles do not "intentionally release" any substance (REACH Regulation Article 7(1)), Laserage has no REACH registration obligation, has not registered and currently has no plans to register under REACH. Nonetheless, Laserage has undertaken a review of the various substances of concern under REACH.

Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs)

A Substance of Very High Concern ("SVHC") is a chemical substance or part of a group of chemical substances that are either already under or are proposed to be under the regulatory control of the REACH regulations. Listing of a substance as an SVHC by the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) is the first step in the procedure for authorisation and restriction of use of these substances. Laserage has completed an assessment of its current products and typical packaging materials against the ECHA's SVHC lists as of the following publication dates and it does not export to the European Union any Articles knowingly* containing any of the so far identified SVHCs in the Candidate list (last updated: June 20, 2016) in an amount > 0.1% by weight.

Number of substances on the Candidate List: 169

***NOTE:** Neither Laserage nor its suppliers intentionally add any currently published SVHC to Laserage products exported to the EU, however, neither Laserage nor its suppliers analyze their products for substances not intentionally added. Trace amounts of any chemical or substance may be found as impurities in any product.

Forward Looking Statement – Ongoing Supply of Laserage Products

Laserage does not expect REACH to interfere either with the supply of materials upon which it typically depends for its products nor in the supply of any of its current or typical products. Since Laserage is a contract manufacturer and does not design its own products, it relies exclusively on its customer for the design and specification of the products or components it fabricates for that customer. In many cases, a customer specifies not only the raw material and other components, but even the supplier of those materials. Laserage is committed to working with its customer to identify materials and sources that meet its customer's requirements. In future sourcing decisions, Laserage is committed to working with the customer to identify any current or future SVHCs present in its products or packaging above the threshold of 0.1% by weight.
