#1 - Not Communicating With <u>Customers</u>



- Share operational changes
- Communicate your goals
- ✓ Work with your software provider!



#2 – Not Communicating With Partners

- Senior centers and related facilities
- Reservation process modifications
- Communicate changes to staff and driver





#3 – Not Communicating With **Drivers**



- Understand rider's reaction to new processes
- Plan for exceptions during implementations
- Identify leaders among the drivers



#4 – Not Reviewing Your Data

- Clean-up data
 Update rider information
 Do it BEFORE
- implementations!





#5 – Assuming Management Needs No **Training**



- Manager understanding is essential
- Responsible for contact with vendors, partners, community, etc.





#6 – No Game Plan for Go-Live

- Staffing coverage
 Procedure lists for service situations
- Reporting process for unexpected issues





#7 – Forgetting to Cheer!

- Change management requires effort
- Efficient software can build morale
- Celebrate the effort
