



Human Resources


- Smoother employee onboarding experience

Real-Life Examples: The Impact of Going Paperless







A network of insurance agents

eliminated the physical printing and mailing of 4,000 pieces of paper per month through an electronic process that saved 200 working hours a month and **allowed them to add three new sales positions.**

A mechanical engineering firm

implemented paperless processes and started saving 15 hours of filing per week, equal to .5 hours per employee every day.
