* PRE-WINTER * Home Maintenance Checklist

Preparing your elderly loved one for winter takes a lot of preparation. Use this checklist to help ensure your parent, grandparent or elderly loved one stays safe, happy and warm this winter!

Inside The Home

batteries.

0	Seal windows and doors with caulking, weather-stripping or plastic window treatments that stop drafts from entering the house.
0	Wrap insulation or electrical heating tape around exposed pipes to prevent pipes from freezing.
0	Have your loved one's heating system checked by an HVAC technician. Make sure to have four or five furnace filters on hand so that they can be changed once a month.
0	Make sure chimney and fireplaces are properly maintained and have had a recent cleaning and inspection by a professional.
0	Reverse the direction of ceiling fans to a clockwise direction to create an updraft that pushes heated air down to keep the rooms warmer.
0	Make sure your loved one has flashlights in multiple locations & fresh



0	Stock pantry with non-perishable foods such as crackers, gallons of water, peanut butter, trail mix, cereal and dried fruits.
0	Ensure the medicine cabinet is well stocked and that they have their prescription drugs filled. Possibly arrange for home delivery of prescriptions for the winter.
Oı	utside The Home
0	Turn off exterior faucets.
0	Drain lawn irrigation systems.
0	Remove excess leaves from the yard and any other fall debris.
0	Make sure low hanging branches near the house or power lines are trimmed.
0	Test the sump pump.
0	Place snow shovels and a container of sidewalk salt next to your loved one's front door.
0	Cover, or remove, window air conditioners.
\bigcirc	Locate and schedule a reliable plowing service for when it snows.
