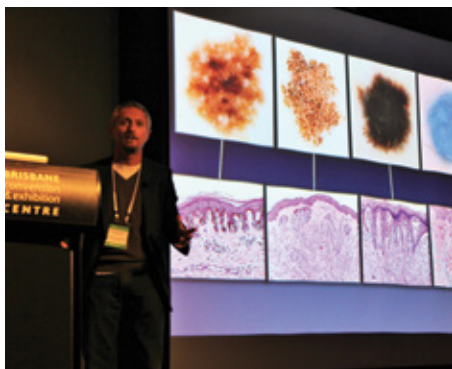

MASTER OF MEDICINE (SKIN CANCER)

The Graduate Certificate and Master of Medicine (Skin Cancer) Program is designed for primary care and specialist doctors with a particular interest in skin cancer medicine or those preparing for a Fellowship pathway in one of the relevant medical or surgical colleges.



Upon completion of the program, graduates will:

- Have a detailed understanding of the structure and function of the skin.
- Understand the embryology, microanatomy, physiology, oncology and epidemiology of skin.
- Be able to undertake a consultation (history and examination) for a skin check.
- Demonstrate an ability to assess skin lesions through dermatoscopy and dermal imaging and be competent in differential diagnosis.
- Confidently advise and manage most patients with skin cancer using appropriate medical and / or surgical therapeutic modalities in partnership with the patient.
- Possess a sound understanding of how to minimise indemnity risk in their practice.
- Know when to refer a patient for further opinion or more advanced treatment.

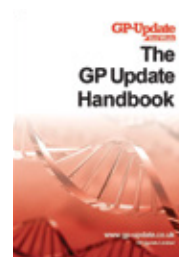
GP CLINICAL UPDATE

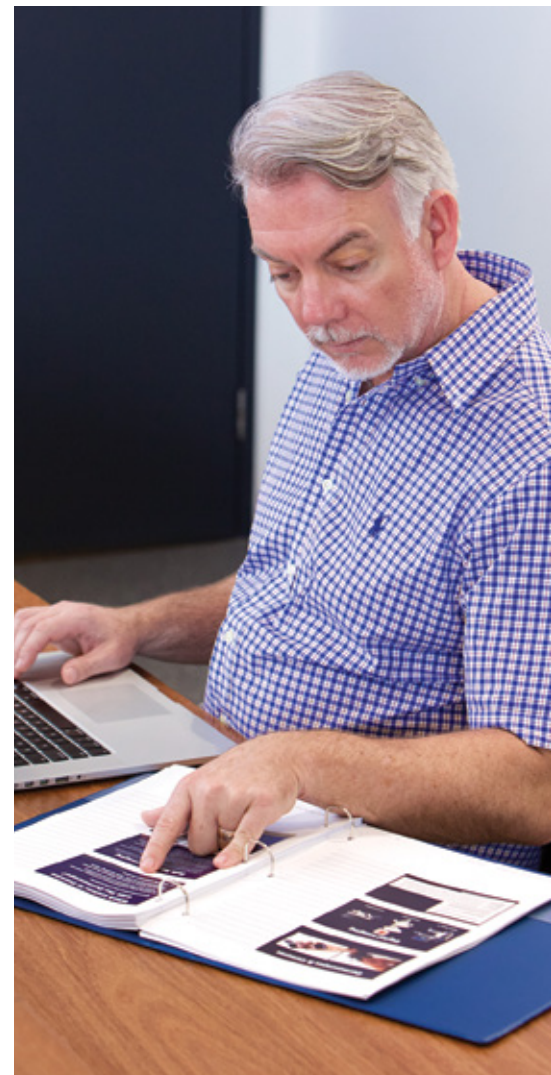
