It's easier to get your prescription drugs!

Beginning December 1, 2016, you can get a 34-day supply of your drug at **any** network pharmacy. You are no longer limited to a 10-day supply or only two fills every 180 days. As such, your retail copays are going up.

Your new prescription drug copays (effective 12/1/16)

***IMPORTANT:** Use the mail order pharmacy to save money and get up to a 60-day supply through mail order **for the same cost** as a 34-day retail supply. To enroll in mail order, contact WellDyneRx Home Delivery at www.mywdrx.com or (844) 813-3860.

I am 65 or older. Why is my monthly premium going up?

The Fund used to get money from the government to cover some of the prescription drug costs for retirees age 65 and older. We don't get this money anymore. To keep providing the best benefits possible, we have to increase your 2017 premiums.
