Policy Statement

It is the policy of Ascendium Education Group, Inc. (Ascendium) to provide equal employment opportunity to all individuals regardless of their race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, creed, disability, veteran status or any other characteristic protected by state or federal law. We are strongly committed to this policy and believe in the concept and spirit of the law.
