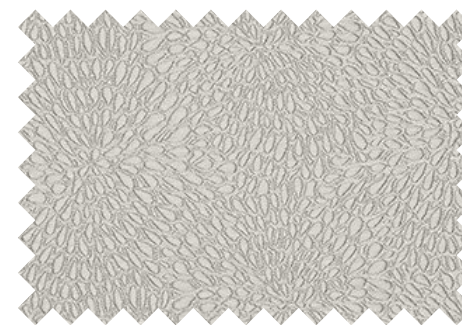


LUSH MEADOW

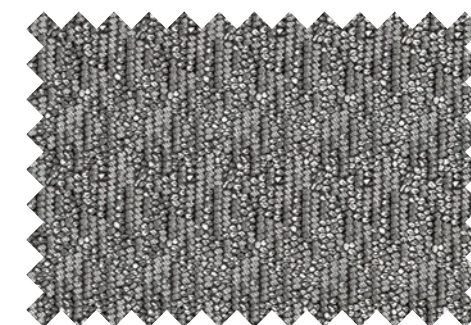
This contemporary shade has become a principle of many color palettes. While it pairs with every color, using opulent shades of purple create and a daring and innovative touch.
