

Connecting your email account to your iPhone or iPad

This easy guide will help you set up your iPhone or iPad to receive and send email using your new account settings.

1. On your iPhone or iPad, open the **Settings**.

Tap Mail, Contacts, Calendars.





2. In the **Accounts** section, tap your email account.

mail.domain.com (where "domain.com" is the last part of your e-mail address)

Ensure the **User Name** is your *full* email address.

Tap the **SMTP** button.

6. Enter the **Host Name** as:

smtp.domain.com (where "domain.com" is the last part of your e-mail address)

Enter your *full* email address in the **User Name** field and then enter your **Password**.
