16 & 17-year-old Drivers with a Learner's Permit

Passenger Restrictions

Only a parent, legal guardian or qualified trainer may ride as a passenger in the vehicle. A parent or guardian may accompany the instructor on any driving lesson.

Curfew

No curfew, but must be with a qualified trainer.

Seatbelts

All passengers in the vehicle, including the driver, must use permanently installed seat belts.

Cell Phones, etc.

Cell phones (even if hands-free) or other mobile electronic devices **MAY NOT BE USED BY THE DRIVER OR PASSENGER** while driving. This includes any hand-held computer or other device with a video display.

16 & 17-year-old Licensed Drivers

Passenger Restrictions

For the <u>first 6 months</u> after obtaining a driver's license: May only drive with a licensed driving instructor, parents or legal guardian (at least one of whom holds a valid driver license), or a qualified trainer. For the <u>second 6 months</u>: may drive with the above people and may also drive with immediate family (e.g., brothers, and sisters).

Curfew

May not drive between hours of 11PM – 5AM unless it is for employment, school, religious activities, or medical necessity.

Seatbelts

All passengers in the vehicle, including the driver, must use permanently installed seat belts.

Cell Phones, etc.

Cell phones (even if hands-free) or other mobile electronic devices **MAY NOT BE USED** while driving. This includes any hand-held computer or other device with a video display.
