THE MATCH-PREP CHECKLIST



There's a lot more to being a successful competition shooter than simply registering for a match. For a successful competition on the range, you need a high-quality preparation routine.

Try these five steps on for size the next time you're prepping for an important match.

1. KEEP IT CLEAN

A CLEAN FIREARM IS A WINNING FIREARM.

The first step is to always make sure that you have a clean, well-maintained firearm at your disposal. You know your gun better than anyone - is it meeting the minimum standards of cleanliness for optimum shooting?

2. CROSSCHECK

From wearable items to accessories, there are many need-to-have items in play when gearing up for a competition, depending on the match type.



4. PLAN AHEAD

The last thing you need when you're moments away from a competition is for something to not perform to your standards. And even the best of crosschecking your firearm might not prevent something giving out the day of the match. So it's important to be prepared.
