Recognized as one of the most effective programs for providing high-quality training and employment to U.S. transitioning military members, the UA Veterans in Piping (VIP) Program offers substantial benefits to all stakeholders. Throughout its history, the VIP Program has helped thousands of service members transition to civilian life.

BENEFITS TO THOSE WHO SERVE

Free Skills Training:

The UA VIP Program helps active-duty military members transition to civilian life by offering high-skills training and guaranteed access to good jobs in welding, sprinkler fitting, HVAC-R (heating, ventilation, air-conditioning and refrigeration) and other plumbing and pipe fitting trades at no cost to participants or the government.

• Training & College Credit:

Upon completion of the VIP Program participants receive 5-years of formal apprenticeship training. VIP graduates can attend the most advanced, well-respected pipe trades training centers in the country, giving them an opportunity to earn additional college credits toward an Associate's Degree - again, at no cost.

Efficient Job Placement:

Upon completion of the VIP Program, the UA will help secure program graduates a rewarding career with one of our local unions once they leave the service.

· High-Quality Jobs:

Filling critical skills gaps in the construction and service sectors, the VIP Program provides training in welding and other specialty fields with current shortages, providing skills for good jobs, that upon completion of the apprenticeship program, pay up to \$100,000 per year in wages and benefits.

Lifelong Careers:

According to a study for the U.S. Department of Labor, individuals who complete registered apprenticeship programs earn over \$300,000 more over the course of their careers.

BENEFITS FOR MILITARY AGENCIES

Helping Our Military Members:

To ease the transition back into civilian life, the United Association established the VIP Program to equip military service members preparing to leave the service with sought after skills that can lead to lifelong careers in the increasingly in-demand pipe trades.

• Reduce Unemployment Numbers Among Veterans:

The unemployment rate is higher among veterans than the national average. Through the VIP Program, military members receive high-quality training before transitioning to civilian life and are then placed into a United Association apprenticeship once they successfully complete the VIP Program, which eliminates major Department of Defense unemployment payments for veterans unable to find jobs

BENEFITS FOR CONTRACTING COMMUNITY

High-Caliber Recruits:

Facing a shortage of skilled labor and a highly anticipated increase in future projects, the construction industry needs to recruit tens of thousands of well-trained, highly-skilled workers in the coming years.

High Value Military Skills:

Military personnel are well-trained in core skills needed in the construction industry - leadership, discipline, focus, organization and teamwork - and provide a reliable source for recruiting high-skill workers for the contracting industry.

Strong Work Ethic:

The UA has had great success working with service men and women. Union members, like service members, receive professional training, understand responsibilities, and know the value of working together as a team.

The men and women of the U.S. Armed Forces provide an invaluable service, protecting the safety of all Americans. Unfortunately, when our newest veterans return home, they face substantial employment hardships and challenges.

- At 5.8%*, the unemployment rate for Gulf War-era II veterans (veterans who served on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces at any time since September 2001) is higher than the civilian population. (*Bureau of Labor Statistics, March 2016)
- Veterans face the challenge of transferring their military skills to the civilian workforce. Though support systems are available to them, these systems are often complicated and many find it difficult to navigate through all the paperwork.
