What is the ReStore?

The ReStore is a home improvement outlet open to the public that sells quality home furnishings, furniture, and building supplies at a fraction of the original cost.

Why donate?

All revenue supports Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity's work building, rehabbing, and repairing homes for hardworking local families. All donations are tax-deductible. Plus, you'll be keeping good, reusable items in use and out of landfills.

Who can donate?

The ReStore receives donations from individuals, building supply stores, contractors, home builders, interior designers, and Twin Cities businesses.

What items can be donated?

Common items include doors, lighting, appliances, wood furniture, hardware, tile, tools, plumbing, flooring, cabinets and much more. For a full list of accepted materials, visit restore.tchabitat.org/donate. There isn't a demand for every used item, so the ReStore can be somewhat selective in accepting donations. This helps the ReStore run efficiently and provide a great experience for all shoppers.

How do you make a donation?

You can drop off items at the ReStore retail location in New Brighton, or if you have several items to donate, you can schedule a pickup. Due to high demand throughout the seven county metro area, we average a one to two week lead time for donation pickup. Visit our website at restore.tchabitat.org/schedulepickup for more information.

Donation Guidelines

Appliances	Refrigerator, freezer, stove, vent hood, washer, dryer. Clean, working; less than 10 years old. No dishwashers, wall or double ovens, microwaves, garbage disposals. We are unable to perform repair work.
Architectural Items	Mantels, columns, framed stained glass, clean. No nails. No damage. No fireplaces.
Building Materials	Drywall (full or half sheets), Lumber (6' or longer), Plywood (at least 1/4 sheet), Baseboard, Trim (6' or longer) No used deck wood. No nails, no screws, no damage.
Bathroom	Sinks, new tubs, medicine cabinets, vanities w/top & bottom smaller than 5'; less than 20 years old. Clean, working condition. No used toilets, used faucets, jetted tubs, factory-molded sinks, shower doors, unframed mirrors.
Carpet/Rugs	New carpet only, rolled. Must be at least 8' x 6' or larger. New rugs or professionally cleaned used area rugs. Please write size on the back with permanent marker.
Doors	Interior and exterior - wood and metal, bi-fold, glass. Clean, working condition. Remove and bag door hardware. No hollow core doors, shower doors, painted doors. No mold. No garage doors or openers.
Electrical/Electronics	Electrical parts, wire (new only), hardware. No electronics, TV's, computer equipment, CD/DVD players, etc.
Flooring	New and reclaimed hardwood, new laminate, and new vinyl. Vinyl must be 8' x 6' or larger. Please write size on the back with permanent marker, remove fasteners, no used laminate, no used vinyl.
Furniture	Dressers, end tables, dining tables, chairs. Clean, in working condition. No upholstery, beds, office furniture, entertainment centers, recliners, sofa beds. We are unable to perform repair work.
Hardware	Knobs, hinges, nails, screws, nuts, bolts, boxes of fasteners, and locks. Clean, in boxes only. No rust. No missing parts. No cans or jars of fasteners.
Home Exterior	New siding, maximum 16' long, new shingles, new insulation. Clean. Seasonally accepted April - Oct. No used gutters or shutters. No Hardie Board brand. No garage doors or openers.
Home Interior	New blinds/shades, new shutters, new wallpaper (full rolls), framed mirrors, new rugs (or professionally cleaned) No vertical blinds, unframed mirrors or glass. No used window coverings.
HVAC - New only!	Air conditioners, Furnaces, Central Air Systems, Water Heaters. Residential only. Seasonally accepted.
Kitchen	Cabinets (drawers/hinges attached). Clean, less than 20 years old. Countertop: Cambria, Silestone, Corian, granite, marble, stone - only with kitchen cabinets. Cabinets must NOT have rot, water damage, or mold. Countertops must not have cracks, holes, cutouts. No laminate.
Landscaping	Brick & blocks dirt free and not broken, New fencing, New edging. Clean. Seasonally accepted April—October. Drop off only. No rot, no damage.
Lawn and Garden	Lawn furniture, grills, tools. Clean, working condition. Seasonally accepted April—October. No rust. No damage. No gas/oil. No power tools.
Lighting/Ceiling Fans	Fixtures, chandeliers, sconces, lamps. Clean, working condition; less than 20 years old. No brass/gold/yellow. No rust. No light bulbs. No track lighting. No fluorescent fixtures.
Paint	Full or unopened cans of latex. No partial cans or used supplies. No oil based.
Plumbing	New PVC and metal piping minimum 6 ft. long, fixtures, parts and supplies. In clean and usable condition. No glued pieces or broken parts. No rust, no used toilets.
Tile	Ceramic, slate, porcelain, marble, VCT. Unbroken, new, clean. Minimum 1 box.
Tools	Power tools and hand tools. Aluminum or fiberglass ladders. Clean working condition. No recalled items. No rust. No stationary large power tools. No table saws. No radial arm saws. No wooden ladders.
Windows - New only!	New complete units with all sashes and frames. Metal screens. No single pane. No used windows. No wood screens.
