

## MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT OHIO SOLICITATION REGULATION

MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT December 1, 2011

## **REGULATORY UPDATE:**

Effective November 11, 2011 the following regulatory change was made in Ohio regarding the solicitation of insurance to Medicare-eligible individuals.

The following **unsolicited** contact with a Medicare-eligible person is prohibited:

- Telephonic or electronic solicitation, which includes leaving an electronic voicemail message on an answering machine;
- Text message, or email contact;
- Soliciting door to door;
- Leaving information such as a leaflet or flyer on someone's car;
- Approaching a Medicare-eligible person in common areas (e.g., parking lots, hallways, lobbies, etc.); and
- Attempting to or contacting a Medicare-eligible person residing in a nursing home, long term care facility, assisted living facility, or other similar residence established for or primarily occupied by senior citizens.
