# Preparing to Get Started

- How does your operation flow now?
- Do you want to continue in this manner or make changes?
- What accounts do you need to start your chart of accounts/ledger accounts?
- Get a handle on your account balances
- Know your current inventory levels

# Accounting/TA+

# Cost/Profit Centers

- Any part of your operation that you want to be able to track profit and loss to
  - Type “S”- Service Centers (can be allocated to other Centers).
  - Type “N”-Consolidating Centers (serves as an intermediary allocation step between service and production Centers), Crop Audit and/or Smart Feeder Required
  - Type “C”-Crop production Centers. (Crop Audit required)
  - Type “B”-Breeding production Centers. (Smart Breeder required)
  - Type “F”-Feeding production Centers.(Smart Feeder required)
  - Type “G”- Group Feeding production Centers. (Smart Feeder required)

# Divisions

- These allow for accounting when there is shared ownership of cost/profit center within a company
  - Landlord division
  - Partnerships
  - Any kind of shared ownership situation

# Ledger Accounts

- Accounts to which you want to report income, expense, liabilities, assets and equity
- If you have additional modules, these determine integration ability
- Bank Account = ledger account
- Very detailed or very basic
  - Sales vs. Corn sales, bean sales

# Vendors

- Anyone you pay or receive money to or from
- If using A/P & A/R this is where you flag vendors for use in these modules
- fein and ssn#'s for tax purposes
- Addresses, due dates, discount rates

# General Setup

- Where you setup auto check numbering
- Where you assign Accounts Payable and Accounts Receivable accounts



# TA+ Entry & Reporting

- Entry
  - Input> General> Accounting tab
  - Checks, deposits, journal entries
- Reports
  - Reports> General> Accounting tab
  - Check register/reconciliation, ledger account detail, income statements, balance sheet, schedule F, 1099's

# Crop Audit

# Crop Audit Setup

- Fields and center/field assignments
  - Fields can be each individual field you farm or more general such as smith corn and be total acres
  - Assign fields to centers for ease of entry, Corn 2012 center would have smith corn field, Jones corn field, back 40 assigned to it
- Inputs
  - Seeds, fertilizers, chemicals, fuels
- Storage locations
  - On farm and elevators

# Crop Entry & Reports

- Entry

- Input> general> crop tab
- Can put in harvest, planting, applications, buy/sell/move crops and inputs without affecting accounting records

- Reports

- Report> general> crop tab
- Crop & Field history, input inventory, crop inventory, landlord reports

# Smart Feeder

# Smart Feeder Setup

- Locations & Groups
  - Setup all feeding locations you want to track
  - If using groups setup current/open groups
- Inputs
  - Ingredient & Rations
  - Medications
- Rate of Gain Table

# Smart Feeder Entry & Reports

- Entry

- Input> general> feeding
- Can put in buy/sell of inputs and animals without affecting accounting, movements, medications, feedings, deaths, move feed

- Reports

- Report> general> feeding
- Open & closed group reports, ticket/ration reports, feed and drug inventories, cost analysis, input history, detailed inventory

# Smart Breeder Setup

- General info
  - 1000 day calendar or regular,
  - Dates farrow to wean, date format for input and reports
  - Do you group feed sows, when do you want pig death reported
- Locations

# Smart Breeder Entry & Reports

- Entry
  - Input> general> breeding
  - Can put in weaning, movement, deaths, abortions, culls, add/delete animals, preg check, re tag
- Reports
  - Report> general> breeding
  - Sow history, litter history, weaning, farrowing, death/cull reports, worksheets, sow cards
