



## How to Use Fresh Cab® in Your Car or Truck

### **Step 1: How Do I Use Fresh Cab?**

Simply place pouches in vehicle to protect from rodent damage & nesting. Replace when scent has diminished.

### **Step 2: Where Should I Place Fresh Cab Pouches?**

- Place 1 pouch under the hood (remove before driving the vehicle)
- Place 1 pouch under each seat
- Place 1 pouch in the trunk
- Use Fresh Cab pouches in your garage or storage building to keep them out
  - For preventative use in non-infested areas, simply place one pouch for every 125 sq. feet, scent lasts up to 90 days. For use in currently infested areas, increase use to one pouch per 8 feet of floor space and replace every 30 days.

### **Step 3: Prevention Tips**

- Mice can squeeze through a hole the size of a pencil eraser, and rats a hole the size of a half dollar!
- Place steel wool in any holes in your garage and seal with silicone caulking (rodents can easily chew through spray foam)
- Protect areas with Fresh Cab rodent repellent pouches
