**Applicability:**

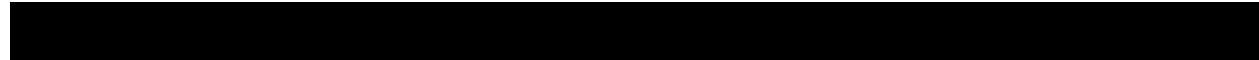
This standard applies to the replacement, use, maintenance, and testing of portable fire extinguishers provided for the use of employees.

**Prerequisites:**

None

**Frequency and Duration:**

This training program requires up to 2 hours to complete. A refresher program is required on an annual basis.



**Purpose and Overview:**

Safety Training Services, Inc. will conduct a training program in accordance with the OSHA Fire Extinguisher Standard (29 CFR 1910.157). This program will familiarize employees with the general principles regarding the use of a fire extinguisher and the hazards involved in fighting an incipient stage fire. The training will also include the following:

- Hands on use of fire extinguisher on a live fire in a controlled environment.
