

Transportation Options

You have a choice of **Colorado Springs Airport (COS)**, which is 20 minutes or less from the Bro^Admoor Hotel or **Denver International Airport (DIA)**, which is approximately 95 minutes travel time to the hotel. The Colorado Springs airport is a very convenient local airport option.

The Bro^Admoor has **on-property** shuttle service to all buildings. Service runs daily from 7:00 AM to midnight.

Roundtrip and one-way shuttle service is available between the Colorado Springs Airport and The Bro^Admoor.


