

Beaded Centerpieces

There's something to say about putting your own touch on your wedding decorations. This great DIY idea from Simply Dazzling Events will let you do just that! Using beaded necklaces from Goodwill, or even your own home, you can create one-of-a-kind reception centerpieces sure to dazzle guests!

What You'll Need:

From Goodwill:

- Beaded necklaces with different hues of your wedding colors
- Glass mason jars or vases— one or two per table

From Craft Store:

- Hot glue, and hot glue gun



Instructions:

1. Cut each necklace so that it becomes a long strand. Take one necklace and place a small amount of hot glue on one of the ends – immediately place the strand onto the top outer edge of your glass vase. Allow to dry, so that you can pull on the beaded strand without the glue becoming loose.
2. Begin wrapping the beaded strand around the vase tightly. If your beaded strand runs out, dab hot glue onto the end and press into place. Begin step one again with a new beaded strand, until you have reached the bottom of the vase.
3. Use your beaded centerpieces to hold flowers or even tea light candles!
