

Belts → Doormat

We found this awesome **upcycling** project from environmental lifestyle expert **Danny Seo**, and couldn't resist trying it out ourselves! With a small amount of supplies you can add a truly unique item to your home décor.

What You'll Need:

From Goodwill:

- **Brown or black leather belts (10-12)**

From the craft store:

- **Leather hole puncher**
- **Hemp twine**
- **Large needle**
- **Sturdy scissors**



Instructions:

Step One: Cut the buckle ends off of each belt. When doing this, make sure all belts end up to roughly be the same length.



Step Two: Lay all of the belts out flat. With the leather hole puncher, make a hole every two inches along each edge of the belt (so two holes are across from one another the entire length of every belt).



Step Three: Thread the hemp twine through your needle and stitch each belt to the other. That's it!
