

Hankie Bunny

We love this fun Easter craft from [Bumblebee Linens LLC](#). You can customize your bunny to the size that you want and use any pattern, making your Easter décor more personal!

What You'll Need:

From Goodwill:

- One lace or white embroidered handkerchief (or a thin washcloth)

From the craft store:

- One handful of cotton balls
- 12 inches of ¼ inch thick ribbon
- Sewing needle



Instructions:

Step One: Iron the handkerchief flat. Embroidered handkerchiefs should be ironed with a towel on top, to protect it. Place the cotton balls in the center of handkerchief with embroidered side down.



Step Two: Fold the top of the handkerchief over the cotton balls to meet the bottom edge of the handkerchief.



Step Three: Beginning at the bottom of the handkerchief, roll material tightly and into the cotton balls.



Step Four: Fold the roll in half and tie the ribbon halfway up the roll.



Step Five: Take the two dangling ends of the handkerchief and pull it toward the body of the bunny. Tie the ribbon again. Pull the ends of the hankies out to make the ears.



Step Six: To make the bunny tail, take another cotton ball and attach it by pinning it to the bunny underneath the cotton ball. Now you have a hankie bunny!
