We love that you can customize the color of your vases to your wedding colors and give your wedding a modern look, without breaking the bank! Once your celebration is done, you can decorate the shelves in your home with a few of the vases as a way to remember your special day!

What You'll Need:

From Goodwill:

 Different sized glass vases. Three vases per table will look best.

From Craft Store:

- PermEnamel paint in your wedding colors
- PermEnamel Surface Conditioner
- Paint brush

From Home:

- Paper towels
- Mixing bowl





- 1. Clean each vase and dry thoroughly. Pour Surface Conditioner into each vase. Pour out any excess and allow vases to dry.
- 2. Pour a decent amount of paint into the bottom of one vase, and use the paint brush to cover the inside surface. Once done, lay the vase upside down on paper towels to let the thick paint drip off. The longer you let the vase sit upside down, the thinner your coating will be.
- 3. Repeat with each vase. Allow to dry thoroughly overnight. Place flowers in your vases for a romantic feel on your big day, or leave them empty for a more modern look!
