

Show Dad your green side with this custom coffee jacket from Fave Crafts. Using material from Goodwill, you can create one that fits Dad's personality just right! This way Dad will be throwing away less paper.

## What You'll Need:

From Goodwill:

- Thick fabric from blankets or pillow cases
- One button

From Craft Store:

- Needle and thread
- Fabric glue

## From Home:

- Black hair tie
- Black Sharpie
- Clothespins
- Cardboard cup cozy for pattern

## **Instructions:**

- Place the cardboard cup cozy over the fabric. Using the Sharpie, trace the pattern twice, and cut each out.
- 2. Using felt glue and clothespins, place the hair tie on one end of the fabric. This will be used to hold the fabric jacket around any cup. Once the glue is dry, apply several stitches around it, to ensure button is held in place.
- 3. Sew the button on opposite end, and side, of the hair tie. You'll want to put it about two inches inside the edge.
- 4. Place felt glue along the edges of the back of your coffee jacket, and lay the second piece of fabric on top. Hold in place with clothespins until dry. Stitch ends together to ensure durability.



This coffee jacket was made to look like tire treads using felt pieces!
