

Bouquet Wraps

We all want to look our best walking down the aisle. From our dress, to our hair and makeup, and even our flowers! We love this idea from Save on Crafts that helps highlight your beautiful bouquet. Using fabric from Goodwill, or even a personal clothing item at home, you can easily make this bouquet wrap for your special day!

What You'll Need:

From Goodwill:

- Ribbon or thin strips of fabric – can be taken from a silk blouse or pillow case

From Craft Store:

- Corsage pins – matching your fabric



Instructions:

1. Cut your fabric into a long 1-½ inch wide strip.
2. Beginning just below the foliage, wrap the flower stems tightly with the fabric. As you wrap downward, scrunch the fabric to add a fuller look. Tuck the end of the fabric tightly inside the wrap to help hold it in place.
3. Take your corsage pins, and one-by-one, insert them in a downward angle, down the length of the wrap in a straight line. Voila!
