

All of the pretty jewelry Mom has received over the years deserves a special place for safe keeping! We love this idea for a DIY jewelry case, because it repurposes an everyday item you can find at Goodwill!

## What You'll Need:

## From Goodwill:

- Cutlery/silverware tray (wooden will work best)
- Pretty fabric (from a bed sheet or pillow case) – optional

## From Craft Store:

- Glue dots
- Vinyl Cup Hooks
- Wall anchor and screw
- Scissors



## Instructions:

- 1. Wash and dry cutlery tray thoroughly. If you do not wish to line your tray with fabric, skip to step three!
- 2. Using the inner slots of the tray as templates, trim strips of your fabric so that they fit inside of each slot. Place glue dots on all four corners of fabric strip, and secure them into each slot, pressing firmly.
- 3. To allow for necklaces to hang, screw the vinyl cup hooks inside of each vertical slot. Once the tray is hung, rings and bracelets can sit in the top (horizontal) slot of the tray! Give Mom her jewelry case along with a wall anchor and screw so she can pick where she wants it to hang!
