

Cinco de Mayo Sombrero

This miniature sombrero idea comes from "Kaboose." We love that you can easily repurpose materials you have right in your home to complete this project, or head to Goodwill for supplies, without worrying about spending too much!

What You'll Need:

From Goodwill:

- Plastic cup (in a bright color)
- Plastic plate (in a bright color)

From Craft Store:

- Hot glue gun
- Colorful pom-poms
- Felt strips in bright colors
- Yellow paint (optional)



Instructions:

1. If you were not able to find a plastic cup and plate in a bright color, paint the color you were able to find yellow. Allow to dry.
2. Hot glue the plastic cup to the center of the plate. This forms your sombrero! Hot glue the strips of felt around the bottom of the plastic cup (the edge touching the plate). If you'd like, you can decorate the entire cup with the felt strips – the amount of felt you use is completely up to you!
3. Glue the pom-poms around the edge of the plate, alternating colors if you'd like. Allow all of the glue to dry completely.
4. Place your sombrero in the middle of a table as a centerpiece. You can also place little candies on top of the plate, surrounding the cup, to use as a decorative dish!



Tip:

- Ceramic dinnerware or Styrofoam dinnerware can also be used in place of plastic cups and plates. Or, try using a small flower pot and tray!
