

We love the repurposing idea behind these teacup candles! Better Homes & Gardens highlights some that even have glitter in the wax. And, Goodwill's great selection of teacups means you'll find the perfect one for Mom's personality too!

What You'll Need:

From Goodwill:

• Teacups (matching saucers optional)

From Craft Store:

- Microwaveable wax
- Candle scent
- Candle wick

Around the Home:

- Pencil
- Oven mitts

Instructions:

- Measure the wick for your teacup so that it stands at least one-inch taller than your cup. Wrap the top of the wick around a pencil and place it in the center of the cup – letting the pencil rest on the rim. You'll want the wick to be straight and taut.
- 2. Melt the wax in the microwave until it is translucent. The wax and the bowl you microwave it in will be very hot, so be sure to use oven mitts when handling.
- 3. Add the candle scent to the wax according to the instructions on the package and stir well.
- 4. Pour the wax into the teacup. Straighten the wick if it moves around.
- 5. Let the wax sit until it is cool and solid, about 30 minutes. Repeat with additional teacups if you'd like!
