

# Father's Day "Trophy for Dad"

We love this fun gift for Dad from Kaboose. Is your Dad the best? Show him that he is with this adorable trophy. Our favorite part? You can use inexpensive items from Goodwill to put it together!

## What You'll Need:

### From Goodwill:

- Two plastic cups, of equal size
- 5-inch square box, or wooden block

### From Craft Store:

- Masking tape
- One gold chenille stem
- Gold craft paint
- Black construction paper – cut to fit side of box
- White paint pen
- Hot glue gun

### From Home:

- Scissors
- Paintbrush



## Instructions:

1. Glue the bottoms of the two cups together. Tape the square box shut by covering the entire box with masking tape. When the glue on the cups has dried, wrap a piece of masking tape around the middle where the two cups meet.
2. Cut the chenille stem in half and glue each half onto the side of the top cup – to form trophy handles.
3. Cover the cups completely with masking tape. Paint masking tape gold, on both the trophy and the box.
4. Write a special note to Dad on the black construction paper with the white paint pen. Glue this to the front of the box.
5. Pipe glue onto the bottom of the cup that does not have the handles. Press firmly onto the top of the box and let glue dry completely.
