

Shown here are Oil Rubbed Bronze, Polished Stainless Steel, and White. Polished Chrome and Brushed Stainless Steel are also available on select models.




To maintain the finish, simply wipe with a soft damp cloth.

Some Towel Warmers can add the sensual scent of Aromatherapy to your warm towel.










Just add a drop of essential oil and breathe deep.

Note: Electric Towel Warmers that are hardwired require an on/off wall switch installed by a licensed electrician.

How to choose a Towel Warmer

When choosing a Towel Warmer, ask yourself a few basic questions:

- How many towels do you want to warm at one time?
- Where is the best space in your bathroom for this wonderful amenity?
- Do I want my towel warmer to match my fixtures, match my wall, or blend in?

Towel Warmers range in height from 20" up to 49".

They come in widths ranging from 16" to 24"

Wall-mounted Towel Warmers project 5 inches into the room.

What size Towel Warmer?

Determine the optimum size by considering:

- The space in your bathroom
- The number and size of your towels
- Your budget.

Typical bath towels require about 22 to 24 inches of space to hang. A larger bath sheet needs about 36 inches. The National Kitchen and Bath Association recommends that you place towels 15 to 48 inches above the floor, depending on the towel warmer's length.

Just keep in mind, you want your towel to be easy to reach and easy to hang.





You won't believe how affordable this daily indulgence actually is!

Quality Towel Warmers range from a several hundred dollars to \$3,000 for a deluxe chrome model.

Timers are extra and start at \$100.

An Electric Towel Warmer, switched on for an hour a day, costs less than a quarter to operate.
