Updating Your System – Options

There are two options for upgrading your system which are outlined below. Pricing and effort are based on averages and may vary based on the unique implementation requirements at the customer site. Please contact your Customer Advocate for a complete analysis of your migration requirements.

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Upgrade from Currently Implemented Version of JobBOSS to Latest Version of JobBOSS

Upgrading to the latest version of JobBOSS moves all data forward to the most current version of JobBOSS. It may require updates to the technology infrastructure, i.e. SQL Servicer and database conversion from Access to SQL, if the current technology is not being utilized.

Standup New JobBOSS Instance - Keep Existing JobBOSS Version as Reference

Creating and implementing a new instance of JobBOSS allows companies the opportunity to start fresh with clean data and an opportune time to changes processes and practices to improve the efficiency of their operations. There is a potential that the technology will require upgrading but the transition from Access to SQL for those customers impacted is no longer required, reducing the risk of potential data corruption.

Legacy data may be dirty and need database clean-up efforts, or not convert well	Historical info only accessible in read-only and cannot be upgraded
