## **Episcopal Retirement Homes Celebrates Completion of Senior Housing Renovations at St. Paul Village**

CINCINNATI, May 1, 2013 – Episcopal Retirement Homes (ERH) recently held a grand re-opening of St. Paul Village II in Madisonville. ERH, in partnership with the Model Group, has transformed 65 one-bedroom apartments for low-income seniors and updated the recreation and common areas to improve the community for all residents.

The event was attended by State Senator Eric Kearney, State Representative Denise Driehaus, and over 100 members of the community including residents, staff and business partners of the project.

St. Paul Village, which was established in 1975 by the Lutheran Benevolent Society and has been managed by ERH since 2008, began the renovations in 2010. They are seeking LEED for Homes Silver Certification for providing energy efficient lighting, windows and doors, appliances and heat and water consumption for the community. The community installed a geo-thermal heat and air system as part of the renovation that efficiently warms and cools the building by using the earth's core temperature, providing significant savings in energy costs.

Further improvements include deluxe finishes on cabinetry, counters, trim and carpeting, and ceramic tile in each apartment. The apartment units were all designed to promote aging in place so that residents can be accommodated as their health needs may change. Additionally, clinic rooms were created for visiting nurses and physicians who help monitor the health of the St. Paul Village residents and identify any potential health issues that may arise.
