



FCC Proposes Fine For Failure To File Form 477

The Federal Communications Commission's Enforcement Bureau (Bureau) issued a Notice of Apparent Liability For Forfeiture (NAL) to a company that failed to timely file its Form 477. The Order adopts \$3,000 as the base forfeiture amount for failing to file the report. In this case, the Bureau adjusted the forfeiture amount upward due to the company's repeated failure to file the 477, resulting in a forfeiture of \$10,000. In addition, the Bureau assessed a forfeiture of \$10,000 for failing to respond to the Bureau's Letter of Inquiry. The company must either pay the full \$20,000 forfeiture or file a written statement seeking reduction or cancellation within 30 days.
