Pastor's introduction

Congregation sings: "How Sweet the Name of Jesus
Sounds," hymn 358

Part One: Savior

Pastor and students speak.

Students and congregation sing: "Joy to the World,"
hymn 62 (*Students sing stanza 1 and the
congregation sings stanzas 2 and 3.*)

Part Two: Wonderful Counselor

Pastor and students speak.

Students sing: "His Name Is Wonderful"

Part Three: Jesus

Pastor and students speak.

Congregation sings: "From Heaven Above to Earth I
Come," hymn 38, stanzas 1, 2, 3, 8, and 13

Pastor and students speak.

Students and congregation sing: "What Child Is This,"
hymn 67, stanzas 1-3 (*Women sing stanza 1, men
sing stanza 2, and all sing stanza 3.*)

Part Four: Good Shepherd

Pastor and students speak. Student continues by saying,

Student: Please join us in saying Psalm 23.

All students and congregation:

The LORD is my shepherd. I shall not be in want.
He makes me lie down in green pastures,
he leads me beside quiet waters,
he restores my soul.
He guides me in paths of righteousness for his
name's sake.
Even though I walk
through the valley of the shadow of death,
I will fear no evil,
for you are with me;
your rod and your staff,
they comfort me.
You prepare a table before me
in the presence of my enemies.
You anoint my head with oil;
my cup overflows.
Surely goodness and love will follow me
all the days of my life,
and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

Night," hymn 53, stanzas 1 and 2

Pastor and students speak.

Students sing: "O Little Town of Bethlehem," hymn 65,
stanza 1

Part Five: Bright Morning Star

Pastor and students speak.

Students sing: "Shine, Jesus, Shine"

Pastor and students speak.

Students and congregation sing: "Hark! The Herald
Angels Sing," hymn 61

Part Six: Lamb of God

Pastor and students speak.

Part Seven: King of Kings

Pastor and students speak.

Congregation sings: "He Is Born, the Child Divine"

Refrain:
