## **Case Study**

Wedding photographer Corrado Amenta worried that hiring a partner for his post-production work would mean he would have to sacrifice quality. He also knew he needed a better solution for delivering his images to his clients in a more timely manner. He could edit the images exactly as he wanted, but it was taking longer as he got busier, and he found that he needed the time to focus on other areas of his business in order to grow as he envisioned.

Corrado took the leap and started his journey by searching Google for "wedding photographers post-processing companies." setup an account on each site and send over an event to be edited. He was able to sign up and submit his first wedding in less than half hour with ShootDotEdit, by far the fastest and easiest. He also measured the ease of event submission, and he found ShootDotEdit was the leader in this category because of the ingenious Color Profiles and extremely easy to use Web Uploader. Finally, Corrado took into account turnaround time and quality of edits. Once the partnership with ShootDotEdit was established, Corrado got time back to invest in his business. Compare his timelines below for his workflow timing before and after implementing ShootDotEdit into his workflow.





#### **Before:**

Day of event: shoot and backup files

- 2-3 days after event: wedding culled
- 4-8 days after event: wedding color corrected
- 8-12 days after event: client online galleries setup and final client package prepared
- 20-30 days after event: client delivery
- 30+ days after event: work with client on wedding abum design and order

#### Now:

- Day of event: shoot event, backup files, send to ShootDotEdit (SDE) for cull and color corrections
- 2-3 days after event: receive job from SDE, review and make minor tweaks
- 3-4 days after event: client online galleries setup, album predesign done, final package prepared
- 5-7 days after event: client delivery and pre-designed album presentation



Prior to ShootDotEdit, Corrado's turnaround time was a minimum of a month, and sometimes longer during the busy season. With ShootDotEdit, his new turnaround time is typically one week. This has led to numerous benefits with his clients, some of them unexpected.

This quick turnaround has impressed his clients so much that almost all of his current weddings are referrals from past clients. The increase in interest has allowed Corrado to be much more selective in the weddings he books, ensuring that the couple truly fits with Corrado's style and vision. He is shooting half of the weddings he was booking prior to partnering with ShootDotEdit, yet his revenue has more than doubled.

In addition, Corrado found the UNLIMITED Plan to be the perfect fit. Being a business person as well as a photographer, the UNLIMITED Plan just made sense to him. Knowing that post-processing is a fixed monthly cost regardless of how many events he sends over allows him to budget and plan for the future.
