

Currituck waives storm-related permit fees

CURRITUCK — The Currituck County Board of Commissioners has waived fees through Nov. 30 for permits associated with storm damage from Hurricane Sandy.

Property owners making storm-related repairs or reconstruction will need to contact the Planning and Community Development Department before starting work because permits may be required, a county press release states.

Damaged dune walkways and dune decks, for example, require a building permit and approval from the N.C. Coastal Area Management Agency. Residents should contact the county prior to beginning any efforts at dune restoration, the release states.
