Subject: TSO-C13d Life Preserver, P/N S-7200-(), Model HV-35C Minor Change Request

Dear Mr. Socias,

The life preserver drawing S-7200-() has had a minor change to it. Revision AM and this letter are being submitted to bring our records up to date.

Revision AM, dated 7/09, revised the part numbering system for two existing life preserver assemblies. Assemblies S-7200-40 and S-7200-41 are now designated as S-7200-40XXXX (Custom Modular Vest) and S-7200-41XXXX (Quickdon Modular Vest), respectively. Assembly numbers S-7200-42 and S-7200-43 have been deleted as these assemblies are now variants of the S-7200-40XXXX and S-7200-41XXXX assemblies (these two vests were identical to the -40 and -41 versions except for the addition of reflective binding used on the vest cover instead of the standard black binding). The four additional digits of the new dash numbers (XXXX) will allow for the inclusion of customer-requested variations such as vest cover color and vest accessories (i.e. reflective back panels, reflective binding, etc).

This change should be considered minor as it does not have any effect on form, fit, or function. We hereby certify that this life preserver meets or exceeds all the requirements of TSO C13d and will be manufactured under the strict quality control procedures on file with your Saddle Brook, New Jersey office.
