I-RAVS® Insurance Verification

Your company must submit insurance certificates to prove that your coverage complies with the requirements mandated by the owner-operator. Pay special attention to the requirements.

Submit EMR Letters & OSHA 300s

Make sure you have this documentation and you keep it updated. Also, be sure your responses in the Management Safety Questionnaire are consistent with the information in these forms.

Safety Program & Training Info

These requirements vary depending on the owner operator, and you will be notified which ones are required. You may will also need to submit training records.
