Erica's Story

Life Made Her Stronger

Erica was frightened when she learned she was pregnant. What would her parents say? What if they wouldn't help? How could she raise a child? Clearly, abortion was her "best" option . . . until God brought her to a Care Net pregnancy center.

rica was in high school when she learned she was pregnant — and she was scared to death.

"I thought my parents would go craze

"I thought my parents would go crazy and not help me," she remembers. When she discussed her options with her boyfriend, they agreed "abortion was the easiest way out."

Before she made the appointment to terminate her pregnancy, a friend told Erica about a Care Net pregnancy center. She decided to go.

Hope Begins to Overcome Fear

At the pregnancy center, Erica met with a caring woman named Patty who had also experienced an unplanned pregnancy. Patty remembers that Erica was "scared like a deer in headlights" on her first visit. But as they discussed the physical and emotional consequences of abortion, they really connected. With prayer, Erica's perspective began to change.

Soon, the pregnancy was revealed to her parents. To Erica's delight, they were supportive.

Her father urged her to choose life. *Erica's fears* were melting away.

However, certain doubts still remained . . . until she visited her pregnancy center for an ultrasound. That event convinced her 100% to

choose life. She remembers, "When we heard the heartbeat and then saw him [her son] moving, we said that we can't [end the pregnancy with abortion]. It's impossible."

God Used Erica's Child to Change Her Life

Today, Erica has a precious son named Christian.

Becoming a mother has had an incredibly positive impact on her life, despite difficult circumstances. She says, "It's made me stronger. It made me closer to my family. It's brought us a lot closer to God."

For young women struggling with unplanned pregnancies, Erica offers this sage advice: "[T]urn to God...Without him, I wouldn't be able to do anything."

very day, 3,300 women end their pregnancies with abortion. Many of them reluctantly make that choice because they believe they have no other realistic option. There are . . .

- Economic reasons: Many women may fear that a child will condemn them to a lifetime of poverty. They may need to sacrifice careers, education, or other dreams.
- **Social reasons:** The shame of being an unwed mother can lead some women to terminate pregnancies.
- **Family reasons:** Many women report intense pressure to abort from spouses or boyfriends, parents, or other close relatives.



How Planned Parenthood misleads the public . . .

Deception 1: Planned
Parenthood has created
"front companies" in multiple
locations — including Texas,
Illinois, Ohio, and Colorado
— to mask the secret
construction of new
abortion clinics.

The Truth: No community wants an abortion clinic.

Deception 2: A number of Planned Parenthood centers are changing their names to more generic-sounding "Health Centers" or "Sexual Health Centers."

The Truth: One official at a Planned Parenthood clinic admitted they are doing this because their name has "a certain stigma in some communities."

Deception 3: A new campaign from Planned Parenthood called "Healthy Moms, Healthy Babies" claims to help minority women carry their pregnancies to term.

The Truth: Despite their efforts to enhance their brand image, Planned Parenthood aborted 305,310 children last year... while offering only 4,912 adoption referrals.

Who Does Planned Parenthood Fear?

f you visit Planned Parenthood's website, you'll quickly discover who *they* fear:

"[B]eware of so-called 'crisis pregnancy centers'.... They have a history of scaring women into not having abortions."

Only in Planned Parenthood's world could "not having an abortion" be a bad thing. Frankly, I don't know any woman who regrets choosing life — though countless thousands publicly regret their abortion.

The truth is, Care Net pregnancy centers offer ultrasounds, parenting classes, material assistance, spiritual guidance, and many other services that *empower* women to choose life. It's nonjudgmental, hope-filled, Christ-centered support that inspires mothers with the confidence they need to carry their pregnancy to term.

By God's grace, we're winning: abortions are down 33% from their peak in 1980.

More Lies Scare Women

Let's look at a few of Planned Parenthood's other accusations against pregnancy centers:

"[They] teach that sexual expression before marriage is dangerous and has harmful physical, emotional, and social consequences."

Here are the facts: One in four American female teenagers has a sexually transmitted disease. A study by the *National Campaign to Prevent Teen Pregnancy* reported that 77% of sexually active female teenagers wished they waited to have sex. These women are

three times more likely to be depressed or to attempt suicide than abstinent peers.

But apparently, none of these are "harmful."

Here's another bizarre accusation:

"[They] may try to frighten you with misleading films and pictures to keep you from choosing abortion."

Only in the world of Planned Parenthood could ultrasound or sonogram pictures be considered "misleading." Clearly, this organization has a problem with people who use science to defend life.



Help Reach Women Before **Planned Parenthood Does**


