TIPS AND TRICKS

In CheckMate update 132 and newer, you can perform multiple CMTrans (Body to Die) transformations, without fear of losing your original start point.

- Simply go into the CMTrans menu, before performing any transformations, and click the new button 'MARK START'. This places the current location into memory.
- You can then perform as many transformations as you wish, and if you need to go back to the original state, simply press the new button 'LOAD FROM START'.
- Also, any geometry placed on a layer that begins with the text 'cmtransex', will never be affected by any CMTrans transformation performed.
