CHECKMATE 12 TIPS & TECHNIQUES

Did You Know....

1) To move a circle/hole measurement up or down its axis, <Modify/Drag Measurement Feature Points> and pick the center normal vector of the measurement.

2) If your screen is looking too 'busy' with too many measurements in a segment, you can hide parts of the segment, such as connectors, datum labels, etc using <View/HideUnhide Segment Components>
