CheckMate 12.02.0078 Enhancement Highlights

Following are just a few enhancement highlights since 12.00.0040. Be sure to read the CheckMate Release Notes for detailed information.

1. Added **CSV stats options** for sorting to the CMREPDEF screen. When sort is selected you have the option to sort by Tol first or Feature first. If Tol first is selected you also have the option to select Summary.
2. Enhancements with Program Notes (CMPROGNOTE) – "Naked" program note now support different comment types for keying in of non-dimensional characteristics.
3. Added full support for DMIS SNSET depth and clear-surf based on feature/datum.
4. Added CMSFKEYIN command to process unloaded tolerances or items marked as key-in.
5. Added automatic processing of unloaded tolerances or key-in items when reports loaded. Also modifier support in place for scripting purposes.
6. Can now global edit the nominal on a surface point when trying to use polar radius.
7. AS9102 report now sorts by Tol labels
8. Excel output now same as fit data
