







CheckMate 12.0040 has shipped

All customers with an annual support plan with Origin International should have received their CheckMate 12.0040 update. This is a new release so the existing CheckMate 12 will have to be uninstalled via the Control Panel, Add/Remove programs then install CheckMate 12.0040.

CheckMate 12 Tips and Techniques Toolbar Customization

Origin support is already receiving phone calls about creating toolbars and losing them when they update their software. THIS DOES NOT HAVE TO BE AN ISSUE IF THEY ARE CREATED CORRECTLY.

Origin has provided a Customization menu for customers to create their toolbars in. Once you get into the Customization User Interface window, you will find the Customization menu loaded under the Partial CUI Files.

All toolbars should be created under the Customization Menu. This menu will be updated in the Custom folder under CheckMate120. Note, if you are designing your bitmaps and using bitmaps other than what is in the CheckMate folder they need to be stored in the Custom folder also.

Now when you get a CheckMate update before installing just backup the Customization.cui and any new bitmaps that were created. Once you have installed the new update of CheckMate copy the Customization.cui along with the bitmaps back into the Custom folder and all will be linked in to the new release.
