Important! Passport Requirements Starting January 8, 2007		
Effective January 8, 2007, all nationals, including U.S. citizens, will be required to hold a valid passport to enter the United States by air and by sea. This also applies when coming from Canada, Mexico, Central and South America, the Caribbean and Bermuda.	The new passport requirement means that all travelers, including U.S. citizens, who are departing the U.S. and intend to re-enter the United States are required to hold a valid passport upon departure from the U.S.

New Microsoft Internet Explorer Breaks Autodesk DWF, DWG Viewers	Windows XP Font Tip
Autodesk is reporting through its network of employee- <u>bloggers</u> that Microsoft Internet Explorer 7 (IE7) Release Candidate 1 breaks its DWF and DWG viewing programs. Users are being advised to avoid downloading IE7 until the problem is solved. It's well worth trying, especially if you were there for DOS and all those years of staring at a screen have given you the eyes of an astigmatic bat. To enable ClearType, right click on the desktop, select Properties, Appearance, Effects, select ClearType from the second drop-down menu and enable the selection. Expect best results on laptop displays. If you want to use ClearType on the Welcome login screen as well, set the registry entry HKEY_USERS/.DEFAULT/Control Panel/Desktop/FontSmoothingType to 2.
