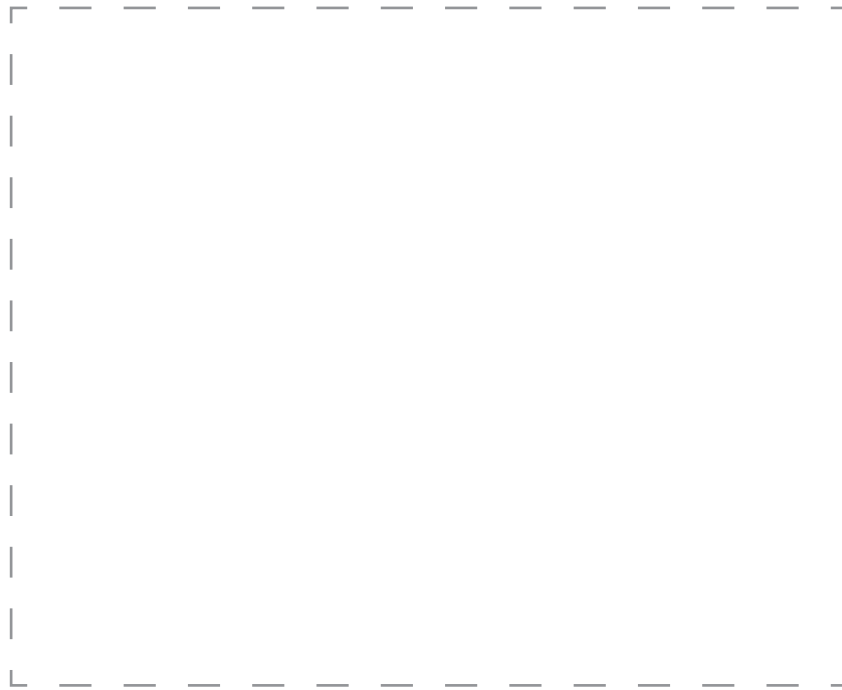

Heart Frame with Picture

Directions:

1. Take time to think about your special person. What do they look like or what do they like to do? What special features do you always see when you look at them(eyes, smiles, hands)? Draw a picture of your special person in the space below.
2. Carefully cut out your picture along the dotted lines and set aside.
3. Take time to color the heart frame on page 3. Perhaps use your special person's favorite colors! *Note: If you are using heavier paper like oak tag, you may want students to cut out the frame first then color or decorate it.*
4. Carefully cut out the heart frame along the dotted lines.
5. Next, cut out the door in the center of the heart. Be sure to cut along the dotted lines only on three sides.
6. Finally, glue or tape the picture you drew onto the back of the heart, so you can see the picture of your special person in the center of the heart.
