Create a diorama scene (or design a scene on a computer) and then write out an explanation for your scene using at least vocabulary words.	Write a short scene or vignette using at least of your vocabulary words in context.	Using at least of your vocabulary words in context compose a chant, song or rap to perform for our class.
Create a list of at least two synonyms for vocabulary words. Feel free to design as a web, noting any synonyms that overlap more than one word.	Create your own vocabulary test using at least of your vocabulary words. It should be original phrases and sentences from you with the correct answers provided.	Create a definition poem for one of your words using at least of the vocabulary words total.
Create a crossword puzzle for of your vocabulary words. Make sure that you include the clues at the bottom. The clues must be creative and created by you (no using the definition verbatim).	Color or draw a picture and label it with at least vocabulary words. Each word needs to be in a contextual phrase so we understand how it is being used to describe an aspect of the picture.	Create a simile for of your vocabulary words with an explanation for your simile at the end of the sentence.
